

Update on QZ8501

Singapore, 29 December 2014 (1930H) – As search operations for AirAsia flight QZ8501 continue into its second day, Changi Airport Group continues to provide support and assistance to the relatives and friends of passengers. This includes regular briefings by representatives of AirAsia, Changi Airport Group and Singapore's Ministry of Transport.

The next-of-kin (NOK) have been supported by CAG care officers, counsellors from the Ministry of Social and Family Development, as well as staff from AirAsia and airport partners. Some NOKs have opted to remain at home and in their hotel. They continue to be updated and assisted by their care officers.

In addition to the 16 NOKs who have departed for Surabaya last night, AirAsia has arranged for another 11 NOKs to head to Indonesia today.
